General Rules & Etiquette

- **A.** The rules and tennis etiquette as adopted by the USTA shall be the rules of the Club, except when in conflict with local rules or with any of the Rules and Regulations herein.
- **B.** In no case should any Tennis employee be reprimanded be a member. Problems or concerns should be addressed to the Director of Tennis.
- **C.** The use of cellular phones is limited to the locker room areas. In an effort to create a unique environment, please refrain from use of cellular phones on the Tennis courts.
- **D.** The following clothing is deemed inappropriate for the tennis facility: running shoes, basketball shoes, golf cleats, cutoff shorts, blue jeans, pants of any sort, tank-tops for men, and sports bras for women.
- **E.** Refrain from crossing over courts as a point is being played.
- **F.** It is the players' obligation to call all balls fairly and honestly on their side of the net and to help their opponents with a call when requested.
- **G.** If the ball from another court comes onto your court during the play of a point and distracts any player, a "let" is called by the first player who sees the ball regardless of which side of the court the ball appears. The "let" should be called promptly before any player has a chance to hit the return or before the return has gone out of play.
- **H.** Bicycles, skateboards, and recreational vehicles are not permitted on the tennis courts at anytime.
