GOLF ATTIRE

Appropriate attire for **ALL** female golfers includes golf shirts, (sleeveless shirts must have collars, collarless shirts must have sleeves), golf socks, golf shorts or skirts. Inappropriate attire includes (but may not be limited to) tee shirts, tank tops, halter tops, any type of denim jeans, jackets or shorts, athletic warm-ups, tennis attire or bathing suits. Metal spiked shoes and athletic cleats are prohibited. All guests must adhere to the same dress code & should be notified by the member.

Use of cell phones is prohibited on the golf course. Cell phones must be turned to "silent". Please be considerate of your fellow golfers. In case of an emergency, please restrict use where other members are not present.

LOCAL RULES

The coastal is played as a lateral hazard and all stones are moveable from any bunker.

RULES FOR PLAY

OBJECTIVE: To enable members to play in a more timely fashion

1. To insure pace of play, there should be three (3) people in a group unless it is a four person team format.
2. If the member has notified the club confirming her intention to play, the clubs should be on the cart at the podium and/or at the driving range by 8:30 AM.
3. Members are expected to be in their carts & ready to play 15 min prior to start time.
4. If a member has not notified the club of her intention to play by the day before she will be placed in the last group in order to not make any changes in the pairings.
5. Any Player who does not have a handicap will have a maximum handicap with a ten (10) stroke maximum on a hole. If a player exceeds this number, they should put an "X" in the lower right hand corner of the box with a ten (10) as her score.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Members are expected:

To keep their score and have their cards signed, dated and co-signed by a member in their group to verify the score.

To record a chip-in they must write on their score card "Chip-in on Hole #__". If they fail to do so, the chip-in will not count for point purposes.

To play at a pace that would take no longer than four (4) hours and fifteen (15) minutes for 18 holes.

PROCEDURES

1. The Golf Director will keep all the score cards & they shall remain on Club premises.
2. Any questions or concerns should go through the assigned staff professional, Cristina Rody.
3. No additions or changes are to be made to the games between Thursday and Saturday.
4. A winner on Thursday may not receive a prize for the same format played on Saturday.
5. Any cancellation of play is determined by the Pro Shop. It is up to the members to call if there are any questions of play due to weather conditions.
6. The Pro Shop will print and hand out the descriptions of the weekly games along with reminders of pace of play and chip-ins.
